### Topics of Discussion:

#### 1) Recording of Committee Meetings

- a) It was moved by Rose Mackey and seconded by Doug Mattos that all committee meetings for Disaster, Fire & Safety be digitally recorded for the purpose of assisting in the preparation and accuracy of meeting minutes. Motion passed unanimously.

#### 2) Charter Update

- a) Reviewed amended Charter by the Governing Docs Committee. The relationship between the Disaster, Fire and Safety Committee and the YLP Patrol team is unclear. Randy Sacks suggested we postpone finalizing the Charter until the YLOA Board clears up the relationship between the two entities. Doug Mattos moved to table the finalization of the Charter until said relationship is made clearer by the YLOA Board. Rose Mackey seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

#### 3) Fire Station #10 Open House, scheduled for Saturday, May 2, 11am-2pm

- a) Darcy Hust distributed the invitee list to Committee members who were assigned organizations to email/call and invite to the event (List attached hereto and made a part hereof)
  - i) Any missing information (contact name, email addresses and/or phone numbers) to be given to Darcy to update the list by March 26
  - ii) Darcy Hust to provide an email invite template for the committee to use by March 26
- b) Rose Mackey to reach out to Lieutenant Lewis to see if he can provide a contact for fire extinguisher charging, and purchasing of fire blankets and smoke/carbon monoxide alarms for the open house
- c) Darcy Hust to create a flyer for the event for inclusion in the YLP Life
  - i) Randy Sacks agreed to print flyers for distribution and publication
- d) The Committee will provide hotdogs, chips, a cookie and water.

#### **4) Evacuation Routes Update**

- a) Rose Mackey has arranged for the Committee members to meet with CAL Fire and the Sheriff's Office at Station #10 on Thursday, March 26, at 4pm to review evacuation routes
- b) Shelter in place locations will be discussed further with the Sheriff's office at the meeting; the YLOA Clubhouse and Yosemite Lake Community Church were mentioned as possibilities
- c) It was agreed that the Welcome Guide, which is in the finalization stages, and the YLOA website have matching information so there is no confusion among homeowners regarding the routes
- d) Randy Sacks suggested updating the signage on all routes and ensure that the roadways are clear and passable
- e) Rose Mackey shared information regarding the Genasys Protect App, which informs homeowners of alerts in the area

#### **5) Green Reflective Address Signs**

- a) Rose Mackey reached out to Madera County Fire Station #12 in Oakhurst. Firefighter Bob Kernagan agreed to have a table at the May 2 Open house for homeowners to order signs for their property. Cost is approximately \$35 for the sign and a medal post

#### **6) Future Events and Ideas**

- a) It was agreed that the summer months are too hot for events, so suggestion was made to wait until after the May 2 Open House to plan anything further. Some suggested ideas include:
  - i) CHP Senior Safe Driving Program
  - ii) Red Cross earth quake preparedness class
  - iii) 2 Firewise events per year
