MINUTES

Call to Order: 4:01 pm

1. Trail Report:

- a. Blue Heron: The overhead and sides of trail needs to be trimmed, a large hole in the overflow parking past the volleyball court needs to be filled, a few small holes in the short loop need to be filled, and the weeds along the bridge border need clearing/spray.
 - (1) Reflection Point
 - (a) Maintenance - the paths, rock borders, and cages around trees need spraying. The new tree needs planting. Marie will verify it is a Raywood Ash.
 - (b) Entrance Marker – will be ordered when funding is secured.
 - (c) Memorial Project – will also be ordered when funding is secured. Tye will put a motion on the April YLOA Board meeting agenda to ask for the YLOA to fund the purchase of the bronze name plaque and the metal memorial tree not to exceed \$2000.00 and for the Maintenance Department to do the installation of both. The committee has decided to use engraved brass plates that will be attached with epoxy to the leaves. These will be available for purchase for remembrance of loved ones and will help to recoup the cost of the project.
- b. Annual trail clearing: a Community Work Day will be on April 11, 2026, 8:00 – 10:00 am, meet at the Stagecoach Trailhead. The number of volunteers will determine whether both East and West Trails can be cleared. Weed Whackers are the primary tool needed, but pruning shears, loppers, and shovels will also be welcome. Marie and Tye will coordinate this event with Cadmar Haynes, the Lifestyle Manager. Liability Release forms will be available for volunteers.
- c. Creek Trail: additional spur to Glacier Court for Equestrian access from the stables. N/A
- d. Jim's Loop: Report on February 28 hike - 6 people attended. This trail needs more hikers to help maintain it.
- e. Revis Ridge: Drone video from the February 14 hike – Rose will talk to Rob Brown about having a version of it without advertising be made available for inclusion in the website.
- f. Stagecoach W: Community Work Day April 11
- g. Stagecoach E: Community work Day April 11
- h. Picnic tables and benches: Alex is recommending new picnic tables will be included in next year's YLOA budget.

2. Recreation Center:

- a. Status of maintenance items: The playground equipment and the swing set are to be replaced/repared. The committee recommends the remaining items be funded through next year's YLOA budget.

3. Pool:

- a. ADA work: A Bay Area vendor for the Inspection Report has been chosen and the contract is being reviewed by legal. This will be a recommended scope of work for the entire Park and should be updated every 9 years according to industry standards.

4. Tennis/Pickleball:

- a. Renovation plan: Tye has located a vendor to do drawings. Resurfacing does not require permits, but a complete reconstruction does. Doug Mattos brought in a sample of a perforated tile that is used for sport courts that will also be considered by the Board.
- b. French Drain: needs to be done

5. Signage:

- a. No Unauthorized Motor Vehicle sign on North Dome: Not ordered yet.

6. Communication:

- a. Welcome Guide: The verbiage for the Evacuation Routes section is being worked on with input from the Sheriff and Fire Departments.

7. Volleyball Court, Horseshoe Pit and Picnic Area: N/A

8. Miscellaneous:

- a. Goat grazing in greenbelts for fire safety: on hold
- b. Trailhead Parking: Completed for Stagecoach Trail
- c. Lake management advice
 - (1) Herbicide use around lakes – only approved for aquatic use spray is used by the maintenance department. There is no weed spray used at the edge of the lakes.
 - (2) Weed Whacking around lakes – is in process.
- d. Fire Road grading: Lilley Mountain down to Sequoia Court is done. The Long Hollow Water Tank access road from Long Hollow Court North has been graded as well. Revis Lane East to North Dome drive is on the schedule.
