### 1. Trail Report:

- a. Blue Heron:
  - (1) Reflection Point
    - (a) Maintenance – The paths need weeds cleared. Alex will pick up a Raywood Ash tree from Belmont Nursery and plant it. Marie will help Angie with the mimosa seedling.
    - (b) Entrance Marker – The large rock at the junction of the two paths will be used for the plaque from BrassTales.com.
    - (c) Memorial Project – Sandra and Judy will write up a proposal for the Board regarding the payment of the \$1300 to William Ollie for the Memorial Tree with a plan for repayment by the sales of engraving on the leaves. The Maintenance Dept will install it.
  - b. Annual trail clearing – Table to next meeting
  - c. Creek Trail: additional spur to Glacier Court for Equestrian access from the stables – table to next meeting
  - d. Jim's Loop: A Bull Pine has fallen near the trail but does not need to be cleared.  
**Hike: Saturday, February 28, 9 am at the entrance to the Revis Fire Road on North Dome Dr across from Quail Ct. Heather will lead.**
  - e. Revis Ridge: Additional loop trail – Micah Johnson is not available at this time.  
**Hike: Saturday, February 14, 8:30 at the clubhouse parking lot to carpool. Joanna, Jeannine, and Heather will share the lead.**
  - f. Stagecoach W: Larry will donate wood boards to redo the seasonal stream crossings. Jeannine will lead this project.
  - g. Stagecoach E: N/A

### 2. Signage:

- a. No Unauthorized Motor Vehicle sign on North Dome – to be ordered next month
- b. Evacuation routes – is being discussed by the Disaster Fire & Safety Committee. This committee recommends including more detail in this section of the website.

### 3. Communication:

- a. Welcome Guide is in process by the Communication Committee

### 4. Pool:

- a. ADA work – three CASP (Certified Access Specialist) vendors have been contacted to submit RFP's (Request for Proposal) bids for scope of work plans for YLP by January 30, 2026. This will

include the Recreation Center, exterior access to the Fire Station, Pool, Clubhouse, Fairway Café, Tennis Courts, and all parking areas.

**5. Tennis/Pickleball:**

- a. Renovation plan – discuss bids – **The committee recommends using asphalt rather than concrete. The committee does not recommend resurfacing the existing asphalt. When that was done during the last renovation the cracks reappeared within two years. The subsurface needs to be evaluated and corrected as necessary.**
- b. French Drain – will require permitting as well.

**7. Recreation Center: The Committee recommends including the following items in the 2026/2027 budget: Snack Shack Roof, Recreation Center Sign, Double Slide on the Play Set, Swings, repair and paint the announcer’s booth, and a plan to prevent erosion on the slope from the Ball field first base area around to the BBQ area.**

**8. Miscellaneous:**

- a. Goat grazing in greenbelts for fire safety – the Fire Safety Task Force is handling this and Eric Jensen discussed it at the January 13, 2026 Board Meeting.
- b. Trailhead Parking – The grading of the access road to the Long Hollow water tank should be done by the end of January. The goal is to have an area created large enough for a truck with horse trailer to turn around.
- c. Lake management advice –Alex has reached out to 2 companies and will also check with the Department of Fish and Wildlife for advice.
