### 1. Trail Report:

- a. Blue Heron: Maintenance: Most of the work is completed. The Bridge on the upper loop needs weed removal and branches over the trail on the SW corner near Corral Dr need trimming for Equestrian clearance.
- b. Reflection Point
  - (1) Maintenance – mowing has been done. The paths need spraying and the weeds along the water by the concrete bench need cutting.
  - (2) Memorial Tree – Marie is meeting with the artist, William Olle, Wednesday April 22.
  - (3) Entrance Marker – The vendor still needs to be finalized.
- c. Creek Trail: additional spur to Glacier Court for Equestrian access from the stables. An exploration is scheduled for **May 13 at 10 am at the Barn** to determine if the existing trail is on easements.
- d. Jim's Loop – N/A
- e. Revis Ridge:
  - (1) Drone video – Advertising has been removed and Marie needs to send the link to William for inclusion in YLP Life and on the website.
  - (2) Some cleanup has been done by Roads on the firebreak on Revis Mountain. The committee needs to hike it and see if it is suitable to add to the trail network.
- f. Stagecoach
  - (1) Community Work Day April 25, 8-10 am at the trailhead – canceled if rain at the start.
  - (2) Stagecoach trailhead parking - An area sufficient for a truck and horse trailer to turn around has been cleared.
  - (3) Picnic tables and benches – The damaged wooden tables have been removed. The purchase of new ones may be included in next year's budget.

### 2. Recreation Center:

Status of maintenance items:

- a. The horseshoe pit needs repair. This may possibly be a community work project by Yosemite Lakes Community Church.
- b. The Playground has been repaired and is open for use. Parts for the slide and platform have been ordered. Bids are being sought for the replacement of the swings. The current bid is \$40K.

**3. Pool:**

- (a) ADA work: The inspection for the whole park has been completed. Only public spaces need to be ADA compliant, so the Pool and Tennis courts are excluded since they can only be used by members and their guests.
- (b) Opening day – May 22, 2026
- (c) Vizpin – will continued to be used and more fobs have been ordered.
- (d) Real Manage has job openings for Pool Attendants.

**4. Tennis/Pickleball:**

- a. Renovation plan – A contract has been signed with the contractor, Tosted, and work is to start May 18, 2026. The work is expected to take 10 days and includes cleaning and filling the cracks, resurfacing, and painting the courts and lines, 1 Tennis and 4 Pickleball courts.
- b. French Drain - Bobcat Company is in discussion to grade the slope, build a French Drain/Swale, and resurface the utility road with asphalt with a price range of \$18 – 26K.

**5. Signage**

- a. No Unauthorized Motor Vehicle sign on North Dome – to be ordered and installed.
