Water Conservation Guidelines-Please Read

Dear Residents,

As we enter the warmer season, YSPUC is asking for your cooperation in conserving water. Following these guidelines will help protect our water supply and ensure continued service for all.

Outdoor Watering Schedule

- No outdoor watering on Mondays
- Even-numbered addresses (ending in 0, 2, 4, 6, 8): Water on Wednesdays, Fridays, and Sundays
- Odd-numbered addresses (ending in 1, 3, 5, 7, 9): Water on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays
- No outdoor watering between 11:00 AM and 7:00 PM from May 1st through October 31st

Water Usage Rules

- All hoses must be equipped with an automatic shut-off nozzle
- Do not leave hoses running unattended
- Hoses used at construction sites must have shut-off nozzles
- Filling swimming pools is discouraged between May 1st and October 31st

Recommendations for Outdoor Water Conservation

- Inspect your sprinkler system regularly for broken nozzles, leaks, and proper coverage
- Ensure your sprinkler timer has the correct date, time, and duration settings
- · Check all hoses regularly for damage or leaks

Together, we can make a meaningful impact. Your help conserving water not only supports our community but also protects this vital resource for generations to come.
