Committee Charter



**Adopted April 7, 2026**

### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of the Disaster, Fire & Safety Committee is to enhance safety awareness in the community and to define and recommend policy and procedure to the Yosemite Lakes Owners' Association (YLOA) Board of Directors (Board) for any and all issues related to improving, establishing and enforcing safety and security for members, visitors, and property of YLOA.

### **MEMBERSHIP**

Committee members are volunteers appointed by the YLOA Board to serve a term of one (1) year. Committee members must be members of the YLOA in "good standing". Appointed members of the committee will sign the YLOA Code of Conduct and Ethics Policy for Directors and Committee Members.

### **AUTHORITY**

The Committee has no expressed or implied authority and serves at the pleasure and direction of the Board. Committee members will not contract with any entities regarding issues pertaining to the Committee without the expressed authority of the Board or General Manager.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES**

The Committee will evaluate safety and security related issues within Yosemite Lakes Park and recommend public outreach and education for the members and residents to include first aid, disaster preparedness, fire safety and emergency evacuation routes. The Committee Chair will confirm meeting dates and times are posted on the Community Calendar. The Board Liaison will participate in Committee meetings to aid in facilitating communication with the Board and clarifying any questions regarding the Board's directives. The Committee Chair will record or cause to record meeting minutes and maintain a copy of the minutes in the designated location.

### **MEETINGS**

Meetings are open to members of the Association and will be held monthly or more often as needed. Committee members shall attend and participate in meetings or discussions. The Committee may invite advisors to the meeting.
